Advanced Connection Viewer is a security solution that simplifies the task of monitoring active connections (HTTP, TCP / IP, UDP, etc.) on your Microsoft Windows laptop, desktop or server computer. Advanced Connection Viewer displays and logs the following information about each connection: protocol, both endpoints and state.

Perform "whois" Operation On Foreign Address

Double-click any connection in the grid to perform immediate "whois" operation on its foreign address.

Log Connection Details To File

Select one or more connections in the grid. Right-click the grid and choose "Log Selected Connections" option. Connection details will be logged to a CSV file.

Log Directory

Click the "Select Log Directory" button to assign log directory path. The application will persist your most recently used log directory path for future reference.

Select Log Directory C:\Documents and Settings\Administrator\My Documents

Automatic Refresh

Enter desired refresh interval in seconds, then click the "Start Automatic Refresh" button. The application will refresh connections grid every "refresh interval value" seconds. Click the "Stop Automatic Refresh" button to cancel automatic refresh.
